- 1. Request Consideration of Change Order No. 1 for the New Bedford Police Station Project to Remove and Replace Concrete Pd
 - Trey Kidwell with Midwestern Engineers requested the approval of a Change Order for removal of tile mud bed and repouring of grout slab.
 - Under the original contract with Fox Construction the tile was to be removed and grounded down to a smooth service. When the tile was removed a 2 ½ to 3-inch grout pad was discovered.
 - Fox Construction is requesting a change order for \$40,856.00 to cover the cost of removing the grout pad and replace with a sturdier material.
 - Ryan Griffith questioned the cost amount and recommended the quote to include a time and material cost that would keep track of the daily labor and material cost.

- Attorney, Greg Pittman said a new Change Order would need to be provided stating the actual cost of time and materials. Greg said Change Order No. 1 could not be approved at this meeting due to the requested changes.
- Trey Kidwell he would get with the contractor and discuss redoing the Change Order.
- The RDC board agreed to not make a motion on the Change Oder No. 1 and would determine how to proceed at the Regular Meeting on Monday December 12, 2022.
